[‡] This monitor meets Hypertension Canada's accuracy standard according to the International Protocol for automatic blood pressure devices. The protocol outlines specific requirements regarding the sample of subjects, test equipment and how the measurements are to be taken.

The studies are undertaken in clinical settings and the results are published in the Journal of Blood Pressure Monitoring and come under peer review. Devices that have met all the accuracy conditions are then considered "validated".

Helps detect an irregular or erratic heartbeat, medically referred to as an arrhythmia, can be intermittent and therefore difficult for doctors to detect. If the PAD icon appears frequently during measurements consult your doctor.
